What services are provided?

Out of home care services are provided at The Giving Ship, located in Indianapolis, Indiana.

When are services provided?

Globe Star takes pride in being a family-centered program and local resource for families.

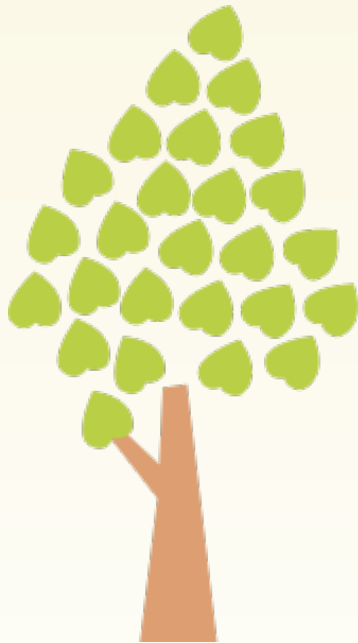
Care is scheduled one month in advance.

Out of home stays are weekend services from Friday afternoon until Sunday afternoon.

How do I arrange for services?

Respite services can be arranged and scheduled by calling the Globe Star office and asking to speak with The Giving Ship Coordinator.

Who is eligible for respite services?

Globe Star is a “lifespan” respite program which cares for persons from three years old through adult life.

Eligibility is decided upon completion of a *Personal Quality of Life Respite Care Packet* and an in-take interview.

Anyone who is within comfortable driving distance of Marion County and all surrounding counties of Indianapolis, and has a child or an adult with a physical and/or developmental disability or a chronic health condition, may be considered.

Who provides the services?

Globe Star’s caregivers with the “gift of caring.”

Globe Star respite caregivers are trained professionals.

Training covers, but is not limited to:

CPR/First Aid

Universal Precautions

Gentle Teaching

On-going staff training



How do I pay for services?
