Globe Star University is a unique adult day program for individuals with disabilities, ages 18 and up.

The concept for the program was developed by caring and concerned professionals and family members who wanted to expand on the philosophy and the services provided by traditional day programs and workshops.

The program is based on the philosophy that all people, regardless of disability, have skills and talents that should enable their equal opportunity and contribution to the community.

Globe Star University provides a safe, secure, and stimulating learning environment where adults with disabilities can learn, grow, nurture their skills and talents, and actively participate and contribute to their community.

We offer a 1:4 staff ratio and provide daily activities that revolve around the interests of the individuals being served.

GSU expands our Quality of Work Life services that provide Community Integration and Habilitation, continuing to implement the

core principles of Gentle Teaching: to *value, teach, protect and reciprocate*.

GSU is dedicated to four key areas of development:

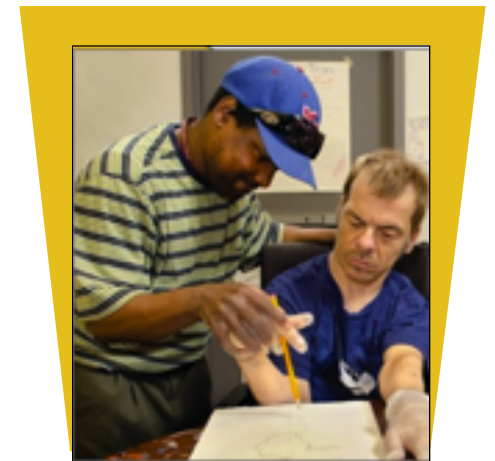
● **Volunteerism** provides volunteer opportunities that enable program participants to establish meaningful connections with others in the community who share similar interests.

● **Education and Skills Development** offer education and training in functional skill development that focuses on individual strengths and interests.

● **Community Integration** identifies and nurtures opportunities for participants to be involved

in leisure and recreational activities of interest to them, and facilitates their use of community resources such as libraries, parks, museums, theaters, festivals, etc.

● **Pre-Vocational Skill Training** provides training in specific job-related skills based on individual strengths, weaknesses, likes, and dislikes, empowering participants to pursue employment in an area of matched interest and skill.
